

The Practice will reopen for limited emergency treatment from Monday 15 June. Please do not attend the practice unless you have an appointment.

When you attend for your booked appointment:

- New infection control measures will be in place. This is for the protection of our patients and staff.
- The dentist and nurse will be wearing enhanced PPE-mask, visor, gown, gloves.
- The practice receptionist will be wearing gloves, visor and mask.
- The waiting room and patient toilet is closed. Please go to the toilet before you attend the practice.
- You should attend on your own (unless a parent or carer required-please discuss this with the receptionist) and bring no bags or other items with you
- You should attend wearing a face covering
- Do not touch the door-wait for door to be opened
- Your temperature and coronavirus history will be taken on arrival
- You will then be escorted directly to the surgery
- Your treatment will be carried out and any follow up appointments will be made in the surgery
- You will then be escorted from the surgery. Please do not touch any surfaces with your hands as you leave the practice.
- Social distancing will be maintained and you will not come into contact with any other patients whilst at the practice.
